- ☑ Preference will be given to Child Development, Environmental Resources Engineering, and ESM Environmental Education & Interpretation students. However, other majors are encouraged to apply.
- ☑ Should have a valid U.S. passport that is good for at least a year from the date of application. If not, the applicant should be willing to obtain one by March 1st, 2018.
- ☑ Should be committed to participate in all aspects of the program: 20-25 hours of planning phase (HSU, spring 2018), 10 weeks of implementation phase (India, summer 2018), and 25-30 hours of reflection and advocacy phase (HSU, fall 2018).
- ☑ Should be proficient in English. Some background in one of the Indian languages would be preferred.
- ☑ Should be able to procure recommendations from two referees at the time of application is due.
